

NBC DOES NOT REVIEW I-693

When National Benefits Center of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services ["USCIS"] receives a packet supporting an application to adjust status to permanent resident [Form I-485], it **takes only the following actions** with regard to Report of Medical Examination and Vaccination Record [Form I-693] submitted therewith:

- is a Form I-693 required;
- if required, has the Form I-693 been submitted; and
- if submitted, is it the correct version of Form I-693
(depending upon the date of the medical examination).

The Field Offices of USCIS perform the full review for sufficiency (whether all tests were performed and results annotated, immunizations completed, signatures obtained, etc.)

Since Filed Offices do not receive the packets long after they are submitted to NBC, you may not know right away if there is any deficiency in the Report of Medical Examination that you submitted. It is important, therefore, for you to check with the medical examiner, **before** you leave the doctor's office with the Report, whether it is complete in all respects.
