DIRECT MAIL PROGRAM FOR I-90

Effective May 31, 2005, all applicants for replacement permanent resident cards including applicants seeking to renew expiring 10-year Permanent Resident Cards) should submit their Form I-90 directly to the following address:

For United States Postal Service (USPS) deliveries:

Applicants should NOT submit the required initial evidence (i.e. your prior card or other evidence of identity) or any supporting documentation with the Form I-90. All required initial evidence and any supporting documentation must be submitted at the time of the applicant's in-person appearance at the local USCIS Application Support Center for capturing biometrics [fingerprints, photograph, and signature].
